

**AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED ENFORCEMENT OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS IN LAUREL HILL SUBDIVISION.**

WHEREAS, the Middlesex County Board of Supervisors has received a written request for enforcement of the traffic laws on the streets within Laurel Hill Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the Middlesex County Board of Supervisors has been requested to adopt an ordinance which would permit the Middlesex County Sheriff's Department to patrol the streets within Laurel Hill Subdivision;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Middlesex County Board of Supervisors that the ordinance entitled "Enforcement of Motor Vehicle Laws in Laurel Hills Subdivision" be and hereby is adopted as follows:

***ENFORCEMENT OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS IN LAUREL HILLS SUBDIVISION***

For the purpose of enforcing the provisions of the Code of Virginia (1950) as amended, now in force and effect and all subsequent amendments, alterations, repealing, or modifications thereto, and pursuant to the authority of 46.2-102 and 46.2-100 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, the entire width between the boundary lines of all private streets within Laurel Hills Subdivision, Saluda Magisterial District, Middlesex County, Virginia, as shown on the various survey plats of said subdivision recorded in the Clerk's Office of the Circuit Court of Middlesex County, Virginia is specifically designated "highways" within the meaning of the motor vehicle laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, Title 46.2 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended.
