

**AN ORDINANCE TO REQUIRE APPLICANTS
FOR CONCEALED HANDGUN PERMITS
TO BE FINGERPRINTED**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Middlesex County, Virginia, that the following ordinance is hereby adopted:

SECTION I:

In order to determine an applicant's suitability for a concealed handgun permit, all applicants shall be fingerprinted. The fingerprints and descriptive information shall be forwarded through the Virginia State Police to the FBI for a national criminal history record check.

SECTION II:

Any costs associated with the fingerprinting or national criminal record check shall be paid by the applicant.
