

Officers of Election, also known as “Poll Workers”

An Officer of Election assists citizens and facilitates a successful voting experience. Officers of Election receive training to prepare them for their assigned duties and follow the Virginia Election guidelines and standards. Officers of Election are expected to run elections in an honest and well-organized manner.

Specific duties include:

- .: Preparing the polling place for Election Day, including setting up voting machines and displaying proper signage
- .: Checking voter identification and process the voter using an electronic pollbook
- .: Giving demonstrations of the voting equipment
- .: Giving assistance to any voter upon request
- .: Directing voters to voting machines
- .: Making sure each voter cast their ballot properly
- .: Maintaining order in the polling place
- .: Obtaining the vote counts from the voting equipment
- .: Completing the paperwork necessary and reporting the results
- .: Other duties assigned by the Chief Officer
