Minutes

March 12, 2013

Call to Order

The March 12, 2013 meeting of the Middlesex County Wetlands Board was called to order by Tom T. Hawksworth (Chairman) at 9:00 A.M. in the Boardroom of the Historic Courthouse, Saluda, Virginia.

Minutes

The Board considered the minutes of the February 12, 2013 meeting. The motion to approve the minutes was made by Mr. Armstead and seconded by Mr. Boyd and carried unanimously.

Public Hearings

A. Wetlands Application # 2013-0140 submitted by Mid-Atlantic Resource Consulting on behalf of John Tennant. This request is to Construct 50' of class A1 quarry stone revetment, 4' high on a 1:1 slope. Site to be accessed from the upland. No trees shall be removed. Minimal grading will be required. All denuded areas to be stabilized within the Wetlands Board's jurisdiction. The proposed project is located on Hunting Creek, at Tax Map Parcel # 40-109-6.

Karla Havens was present to represent the application and to explain the proposed project.

Chairman Hawksworth opened the hearing for comments from the public.

There being no additional comments, the public portion of the hearing was closed.

Chairman Hawksworth began a brief period of questions and comments between the Board and the agent.

There being no further questions or comments from the Board, Chairman Hawksworth asked for disposition of the application. The motion to approve the application as submitted was made by Mrs. Sanders and seconded by Mr. Armstead and carried unanimously with a 18 month time limit with the following conditions:

Revetment to be placed landward of existing grasses & no damage to occur to grasses during construction

Mrs. Sanders asked staff if they had worked on storm damage policy. Staff indicated that they had not.

Mrs. Sanders made a motion to adjourn the meeting; it was seconded by Mr. Boyd and carried unanimously.
