### **Minutes**

**March 11, 2014**

#### **Call to Order**

The February 11, 2014 meeting of the Middlesex County Wetlands Board was called to order by Fred W. Dolezal (Chairman) at 9:00 A.M. in the Boardroom of the Historic Courthouse, Saluda, Virginia.

#### **Minutes**

The Board considered the minutes of the February 11, 2014 meeting. The motion to approve the minutes was made by Mr. Boyd and seconded by Mrs. Sanders and carried unanimously.

#### **Public Hearings**

**A. Wetlands Application # 2013-1694** submitted by Michelle Meredith on behalf of Pete Alcorn. This request is to Hydraulically dredge material across wetlands to an upland 16'x30' geobag. Piping will be only materials that will lay over vegetated wetlands with mats to be used under piping within the Wetlands Board's jurisdiction. The proposed project is located on Moore Creek, at Tax Map Parcel # 45-11A.

There was no one present to represent the application and to explain the proposed project.

Chairman Dolezal opened the hearing for comments from the public.

There being no additional comments, the public portion of the hearing was closed.

There being no further questions or comments from the Board, Chairman Dolezal asked for disposition of the application.

The motion to continue the application as submitted was made by Mr. Armstead and seconded by Mrs. Sanders and carried unanimously.

**B. Wetlands Application # 2013-1704** submitted by Joseph A. Scott on behalf of Howard & Laurie Hardin. This request is to Install 230' of vinyl bulkhead immediately channelward of existing failing timber bulkhead with 12' and 8' return walls. Install 240' of rip rap sill (Class A1) with 2400sf (100 cu.yds) of sand nourishment and associated wetland plantings within the Wetlands Board's jurisdiction. The proposed project is located on Locklies Creek, at Tax Map Parcel # 30-70A.

Joey Scott was present to represent the application and to explain the proposed project.

Chairman Dolezal opened the hearing for comments from the public.

There being no additional comments, the public portion of the hearing was closed.

Chairman Dolezal began a brief period of questions and comments between the Board and the agent.

There being no further questions or comments from the Board, Chairman Dolezal asked for disposition of the application.

The motion to approve the application as submitted was made by Mr. Armstead and seconded by Mr. Boyd and carried unanimously with the following Condition: Mats are to be used if wetlands vegetation is to be crossed during construction.
