#### **Call to Order**

#### **Minutes**

The Board considered the minutes of the March 11, 2014 meeting. The motion to approve the minutes was made by Mr. Boyd and seconded by Mrs. Sanders and carried unanimously.

#### **Public Hearings**

**A. Wetlands Application # 2013-1694** submitted by Michelle Meredith on behalf of Pete Alcorn. This request is to Hydraulically dredge material across wetlands to an upland 16'x30' geobag. Piping will be only materials that will lay over vegetated wetlands with mats to be used under piping within the Wetlands Board's jurisdiction. The proposed project is located on Moore Creek, at Tax Map Parcel # 45-11A.

Michelle Meredith was present to represent the application and to explain the proposed project.

Chairman Dolezal noted that having previously opened the hearing for comments from the public during the March 11, 2014 public hearing that the public hearing portion would remain closed.

Chairman Dolezal began a brief period of questions and comments between the Board and the agent.

There being no further questions or comments from the Board, Chairman Dolezal asked for disposition of the application.

The motion to approve the application as submitted was made by Mrs. Sanders and seconded by Mr. Boyd and carried unanimously with an 18 month time limit.

**B. Wetlands Application # 2014-0047** submitted by Michelle Meredith on behalf of Chick Cove Association c/o Leon Holzman. This request is to Install 20' of filter cloth along the north side of boat ramp at the MLW mark, installing A1A rip rap over filter cloth then backfilling along the boat ramp 100% clean fill sand. Remove pine tree on bank to allow vegetation growth within the Wetlands Board's jurisdiction. The proposed project is located on Healy Creek, at Tax Map Parcel # 39D-1-18.

Michelle Meredith was present to represent the application and to explain the proposed project.

Chairman Dolezal opened the hearing for comments from the public.

There being no additional comments, the public portion of the hearing was closed.

Chairman Dolezal began a brief period of questions and comments between the Board and the agent.

There being no further questions or comments from the Board, Chairman Dolezal asked for disposition of the application.
