April 14, 2015

Call to Order

The Board considered the minutes of the March 10, 2015 meeting. The motion to approve the minutes was made by Mrs. Sanders and seconded by Mr. Laughton and carried unanimously.

Public Hearings

A. Wetlands Application # 2015-0245 submitted by Michelle Meredith on behalf of Bridge Marinas LLC c/o John Mullins. This request is to Replace 35' of timber bulkhead with new C-Lock 9000 vinyl bulkhead channelward of existing with a 2' return in conjunction with a marina renovation project within the Wetlands Board's jurisdiction. The proposed project is located on Urbanna Creek, at Tax Map Parcel # 20A-1-88, 89 & 91.

Michelle Meredith present to represent the application and to explain the proposed project.

Chairman Dolezal opened the hearing for comments from the public.

There being no additional comments, the public portion of the hearing was closed.

Chairman Dolezal began a brief period of questions and comments between the Board and the agent.

There being no further questions or comments from the Board, Chairman Dolezal asked for disposition of the application.

The motion to approve the application, as submitted, was made by Mrs. Sanders and seconded by Mr. Boyd and carried unanimously with a 3 year time limit.

On a motion by Chairman Dolezal and a second by Mr. Laughton, the Board passed a resolution to make money, from the civil charge fund, readily available for staff and Board Member education for wetlands purposes.

Staff also briefed the Board on the Jamison Cove application located on the town of Urbanna property.
